- 1. Who is an agriculturist for the purpose of the proviso to Section 60 CPC?
- 2. When can service of summons to a defendant be made on an adult member of his family?
- 3. When can the court order that pleadings be struck out?
- 4. A plaint was rejected on the ground that it was not filed in duplicate.

  The plaintiff filed a fresh suit. The only contention of the defendant was that the rejection amounted to a decree. Comment.
- 5. In a suit for recovery of Rs.1,00,000/- the defendant appeared and filed a written statement admitting his liability to pay Rs.50,000/- and denying the liability to pay the balance amount. When the suit was called on for hearing the plaintiff was absent. The court decreed the suit in part and dismissed it in part. What is the remedy of the plaintiff?
- 6. What is the object of delivering interrogatories?
- 7. What is the procedure to be followed when a court rejects in evidence a document produced in a suit?
- 8. A Munsiff found that he had no territorial jurisdiction to entertain the suit and ordered return of the plaint. He also directed the parties to maintain status quo for two weeks or till the plaint was represented in the proper court, whichever was earlier. Comment.
- 9. A judgment debtor in a decree for perpetual injunction violated it. What is the mode of execution?
- 10. How is attachment of a debt not secured by a negotiable instrument effected?

- 11. With regard to the jurisdiction of an executing court what is the difference between attachment of salary of a government employee and of a private employee?
- 12. In execution of a decree an immovable property was attached. Later, the decree was reversed. What is its effect on the attachment?
- 13. A, B and C, partners of a firm, filed a suit for recovery of a sum. C died pending the suit. His legal representatives were not made parties to the suit. The defendant contended that the suit abated as against C. Can it be upheld? Why?
- 14. What is the period during which an order passed by a vacation judge will be in force in a matter which ought to have been filed in a Munsiff's Court?
- 15. Where can a proceedings u/s.125 Cr.P.C be taken?
- 16. When is it mandatory for a Judicial Magistrate to conduct an enquiry u/s.176(1)A Cr.P.C?
- 17. What are the grounds on which a Magistrate may discharge an accused in a complaint case?
- 18. What are the powers of a Magistrate with regard to recording of evidence and awarding of sentence in a summary trial?
