

BA Philosophy Entrance Test
Guidelines

The Entrance test will have 40 questions of 2 marks each, with negative marking for wrong responses. The questions will be in English, and will test Reasoning, General knowledge and Comprehension, as well as knowledge in the general area of the subject.

Sample questions:

Q1. Which state is the site for India's first hydro-engineering college?

- a) Himachal Pradesh
- b) Odisha
- c) West Bengal
- d) Kerala

2. All Presidentians are great people. Some great people live in Kolkata. Ram lives in Kolkata. That being the case, which of the following statements is correct?

- a) Ram is a great person.
- b) Ram is a Presidentian.
- c) Some Presidentians live in Kolkata.
- d) None of the above

3. X is a positive integer that is greater than 39 and smaller than 61. $X/2$ (X divided by 2) is a prime number and is not the successor of a multiple of 11. Then, which of the following statements is correct?

- a) X is smaller than 55.
- b) $X = 44$.
- c) $X = 58$.
- d) X is a multiple of 11.

4. The founder of Yoga Philosophy is:

- a) Patanjali
- b) Gautama
- c) Kapila
- d) Jaimini

There will also be questions testing comprehension from a passage.
