8. If you were running a race and you passed the person in 2nd place, what place would you be in now?

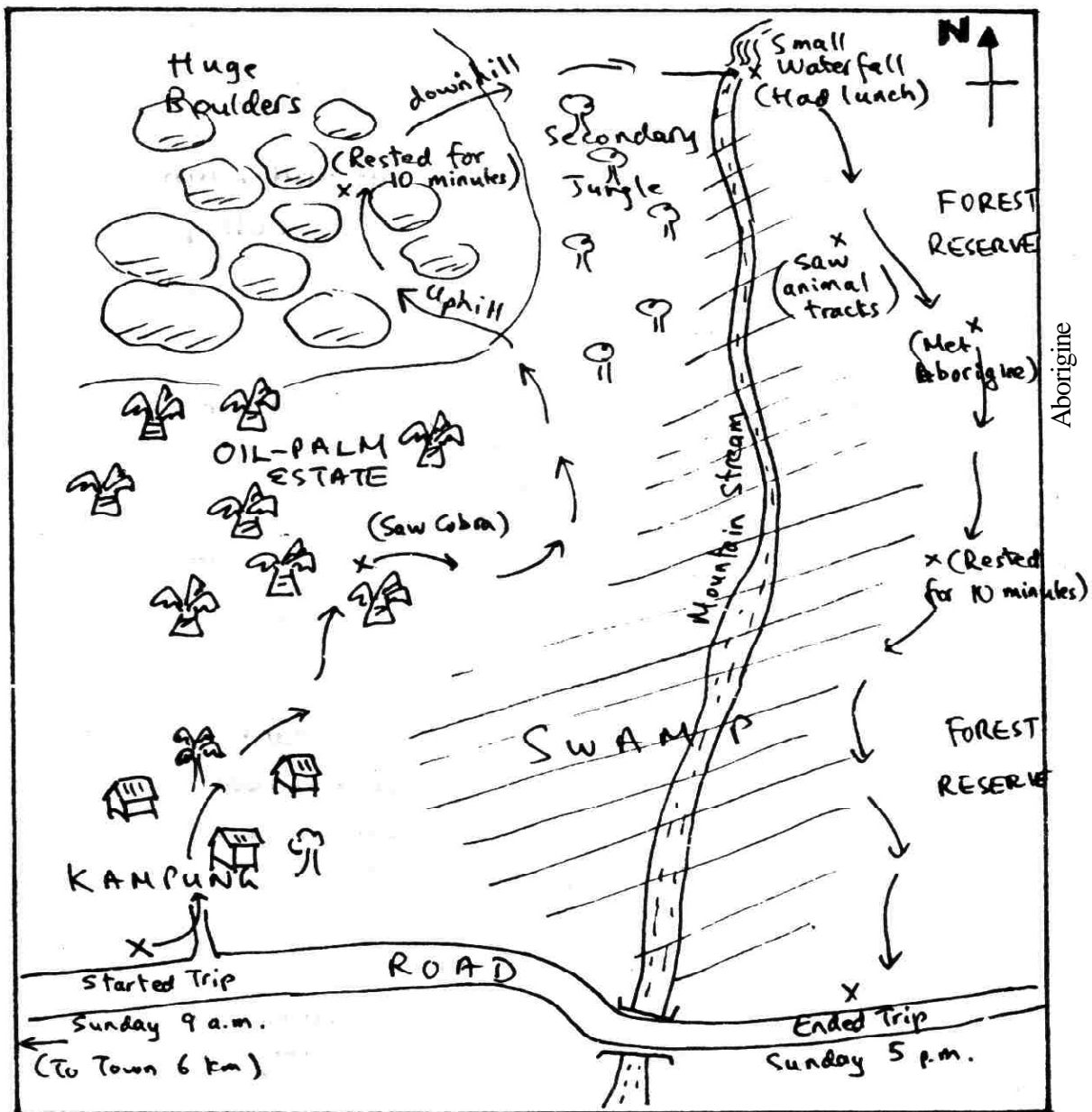

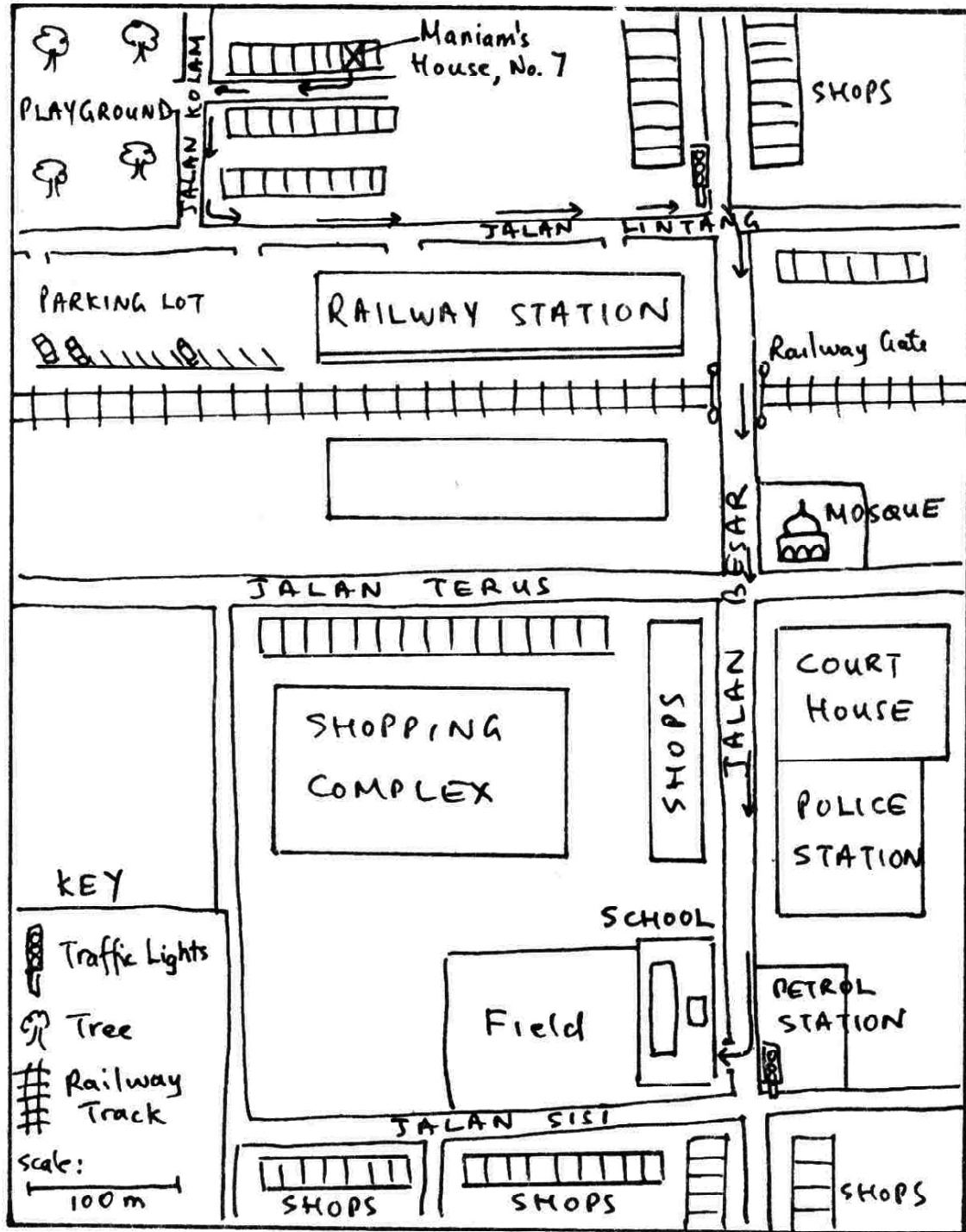

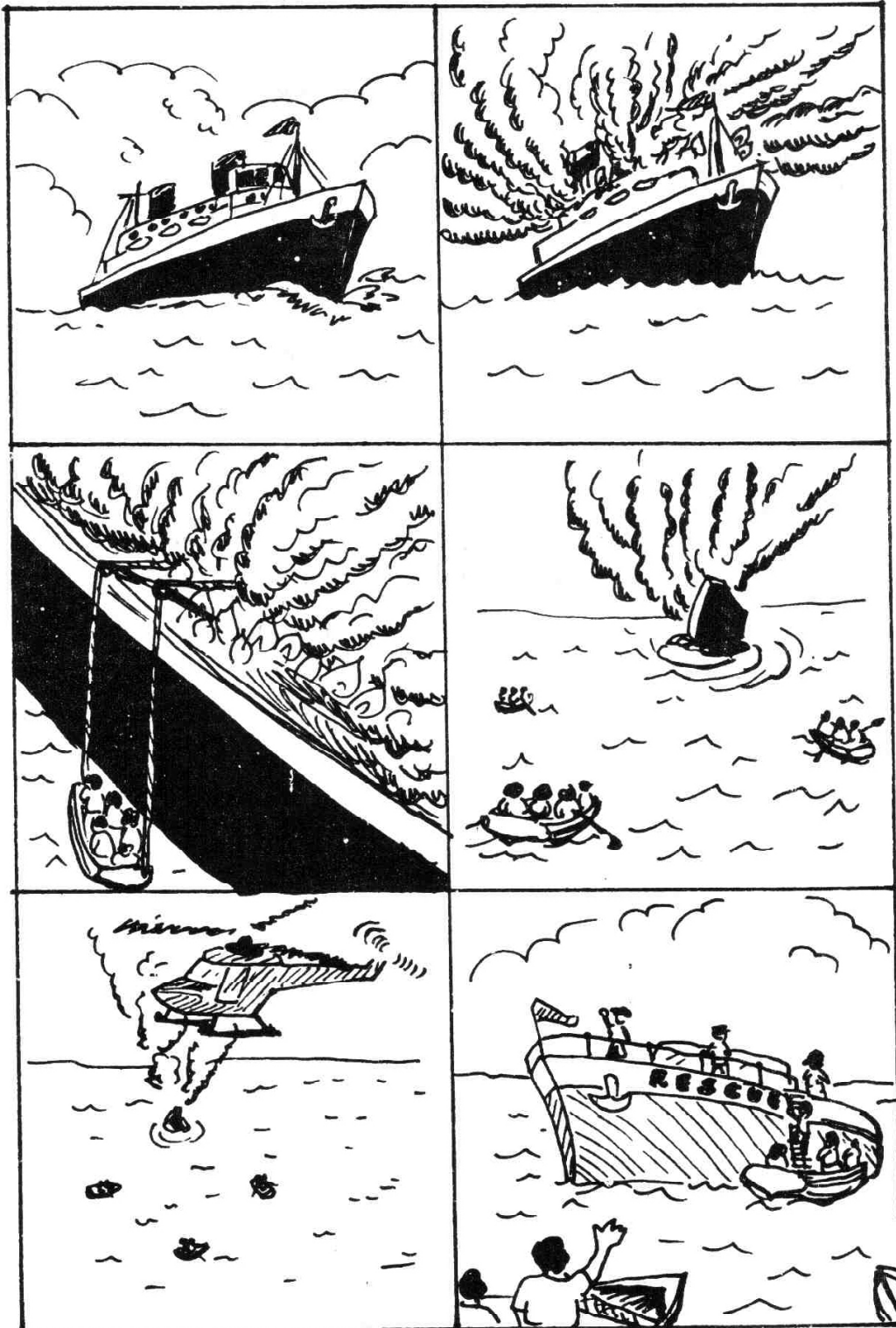

12. Maniam takes a regular route to his school every morning on his bicycle. Describe what he may see on his ride, mentioning any landmarks and other things of interest.

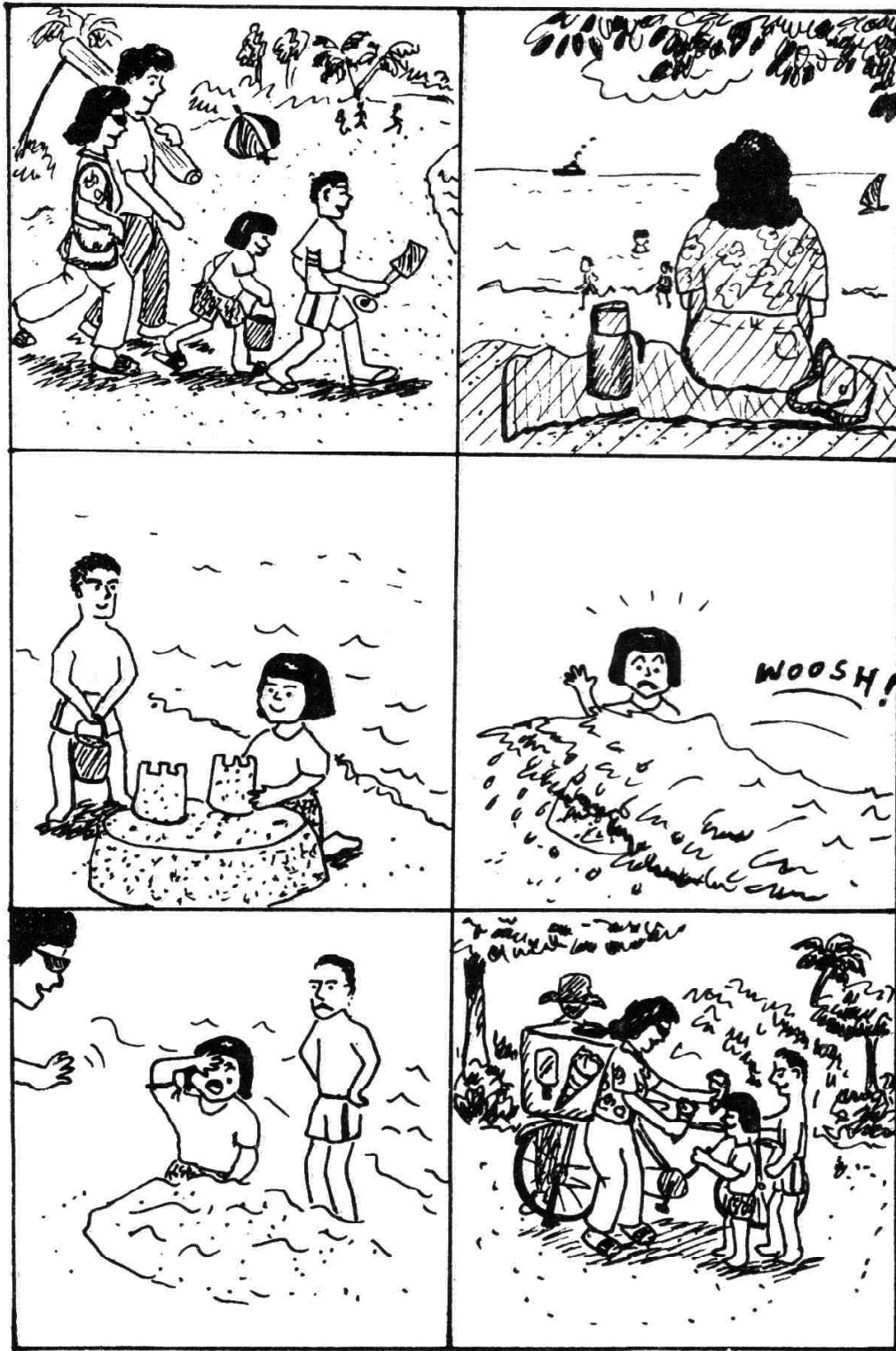

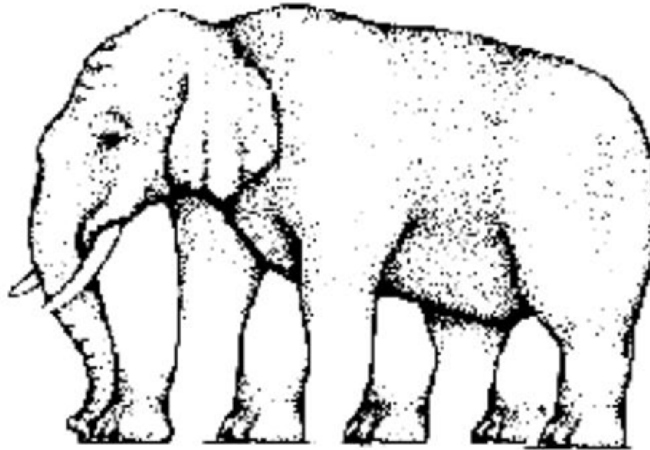

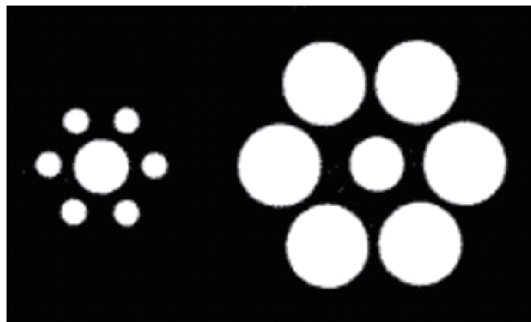
15. How many legs does this elephant have?

17. Is the left center circle larger than the right center circle in the image below?



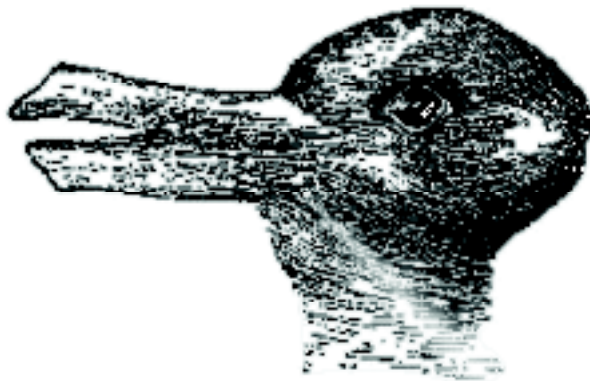
